## INCIDENT REPORT- POSSESSION OF A FAKE WEAPON ON SCHOOL PREMISES.

On the 23rd of April, a serious incident occurred involving one of our students, Diego Di Gioia, who bought and brought a fake firearm into the classroom

The incident was reported by the class teacher during the break. Upon receiving the report, I immediately informed the group leaders and together we addressed the matter directly with the students in the classroom. After a brief discussion, I requested that the item be handed over, and it was subsequently confiscated.

Due to the nature of the incident and its emotional impact on the teacher involved, it was necessary to cancel the remainder of the lesson for the wellbeing of both the staff and students.

Below is the teacher's account of the event:

**Teacher Report:**

*"Today a student brought a fake gun to my classroom.*

*As I turned the corner into my classroom, a student (Samuel Miglietta) was aiming at another student, and I walked between them without initially realising what was happening. I only noticed the gun when it was pointed in my direction. I was shocked and immediately asked the students to put it away. However, the item continued to be passed around during the lesson.*

*I chose to wait until the break to report the incident, as I wanted to try and address the issue by sharing my own experience of living in Chicago and explaining the emotional weight and potential trauma associated with seeing a gun in a classroom setting. One student, Raffaele, kindly translated for the others, but unfortunately, the group did not seem to take the situation seriously and dismissed it as a joke.*

*While I was able to continue teaching for a short time, I made the decision to escalate the issue to school management during the break.*

*I would like to highlight that Raffaele was extremely helpful and demonstrated a clear understanding of the seriousness of the situation. I've marked attendance with a star to indicate the student who held the item the longest, though I do not yet know all the names."*

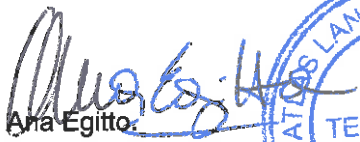
This incident represents a serious violation of our school's code of conduct and is not in alignment with the values upheld by Atlas Language School. As a result, the following measures have been taken:

Diego Di Gioia will not be issued a certificate of attendance and is prohibited from attending further classes or participating in any group activities for the remainder of the programme.

In light of multiple complaints previously received regarding this group's behaviour, it must be clearly stated that any further incidents or disciplinary issues will result in the immediate termination of the programme and the group being sent home.

The group leaders have been fully informed of the situation, and we acknowledge and appreciate their support and concern. They are in full agreement with the actions taken by the school.
