Since their arrival, this group has presented ongoing challenges in terms of behaviour. On their first day, they were given clear and specific instructions regarding expected conduct during classes and scheduled activities. However, they have consistently disregarded these guidelines.

Multiple warnings had to be issued due to students smoking in prohibited areas — including, on one occasion, inside the bathrooms. They also entered the residence building without authorisation, despite being fully aware that access was not permitted.

The school premises host other student groups with different class schedules. While Group Losurdo C was on their break, another group was in session. Despite this, members of Losurdo C repeatedly disrupted the ongoing class by entering the classroom without permission, disturbing not only the teacher but also the students who were actively engaged in learning.

Our building is shared with a Ukrainian refugee center, and the bathrooms are jointly used by both the school and the center. We placed signs requesting silence when entering this section, as there are also classes held within the refugee center. Despite having made multiple requests for silence, the students have consistently ignored them, causing disruptions and bringing problems with the refugee center.

Finally, on the 23rd of April, we had an incident involving a fake gun. This incident has been detailed in the report titled: **INCIDENT REPORT - POSSESSION OF A FAKE WEAPON ON SCHOOL PREMISES.**

It is important to clarify that while one student purchased (Diego De Gioa) the gun and another (pointed it at the teacher upon entering the classroom, the entire group acted in complicity that day in the classroom. When I spoke with them, along with the group leaders, they laughed and kept insisting that it was just a joke, and they didn't understand what the problem was.

It is worth noting that in his final report, the Atlas teacher mentioned that Settimio Raffaele Gravili and Nicolò Anthony Schettini were the only two students who immediately understood the seriousness of the situation. They attempted to assist at the moment by translating what the teacher was saying and later apologized to him.
